Lee Shayler, a blind Highlands Ranch resident will be recreating Captain Robert Barclay Allardice's '1000 miles in 1000 hours' Challenge from April 25th to June 5th this year. It is for two very worthy vision related charities, Foundation Fighting Blindness & the British Retinitis Pigmentosa Society.

Lee will be walking 1 mile every consecutive hour for 42 days.

This walk will be taking place at six parks around Highlands Ranch, including Heritage, Falcon, Toepfer, Marcy, Plum Valley & Redstone. He will be walking with a small group of volunteers, who will be on hand to assist him during the walk at each location. There will be a support RV, which will be there for up to seven days at a time. During evening and early morning hours, the number of support walkers will be limited to minimize any impact on park neighbors.
